INTRODUCTION

The struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but is rather in nature; and the epistle of Jude should be considered a missive to the church, in the face of this spiritual battle.		
Jude wants to do more than just give us the intelligence we need about the enemy. He wants to make sure that as we fight for truth and holiness, we have thethat we need.		
3 STRATEGIES FOR THE SPIRITUAL BATTLE		
Strategy #1: "for they said to you, 'In the last time there will be scoffers, indulging their own ungodly lusts.'" (Jude 1:18)		
"It is these worldly people, <u>devoid of the Spirit</u> , who are <u>causing divisions</u> " (Jude 1:19)		
Jude is doing more here than simply repeating his description of the false teachers' mistakes—he's also focussing our attention on the importance of

When it comes to equipping the church to stand firm and stay faithful in the battle, Jude directs our gaze to the apostolic witness—which is theas contained in the NT of the Bible.
